- Ability to differentiate instruction.
- Experience with Learning Management Systems (ex: CANVAS or Google Classroom) is preferred.
- Attentiveness to the social-emotional needs of young adolescent students.
- Willingness and desire to mentor students.
- A passion for curriculum design, innovation and ongoing professional development.
- Ability to work collaboratively with other teachers and administrators.
- Ability to teach multiple levels of middle school mathematics.

### **Key Responsibilities Include:**

- Mastery of content areas including but not limited to: advanced arithmetic, geometry and algebra 1.
- Facilitate advisory and homeroom periods.
- Offer elective courses in math or science.
- Participate in faculty, grade-level and department meetings.
